

Ampelite Lexan* Thermoclear* is a high quality low maintenance glazing material that is built to last. Lexan polycarbonate resin delivers high impact strength, an excellent balance of low weight and high stiffness and naturally very clear transparency.

UV Protection

The Ampelite Lexan* Thermoclears* versatility allows for a multitude of applications including roofing, wall cladding, glazing and partitioning. The sheeting is suitable for use in vertical, sloped or curved scenarios.

Ampelite Lexan* Thermoclear* blocks 99.9% of harmful UV radiation. The proprietary surface treatment represents the next generation in surface coating technology. Both sides of the sheeting feature UV protection giving superior resistance to outdoor weathering and greater design flexibility.

Fire Performance

Ampelite Lexan* Thermoclear* is suitable for use in bushfire prone zones BAL's 19 and below. It is flame resistant, self extinguishing, stops the spread of flame and develops minimal smoke. Ampelite Lexan* Thermoclear* complies with AS/NZS 1530.3: 2006 for simultaneous determination of ignitability, flame propagation, heat release and smoke release; AS/NZS 3837: 1998 for heat and smoke release rates for material and products using an oxygen consumption calorimeter; AS3959 Construction of buildings in bushfire-prone areas. 

Available Sheet Structures


Ampelite recommend using standard gauge 10 mm twinwall sheeting for most residential and smaller commercial applications.

10mm twin wall Sheet structure




16mm twin wall Sheet structure



This represents a revolutionary development in the use of plastic sheeting in Australia's harsh climate.

SunXP offers a 15 year warranty against excessive yellowing, loss of light transmission and hail damage.

Specification

"The translucent sheeting shall be 'Ampelite Lexan* Thermoclear* multiwall sheet as distributed by Ampelite Australia Pty Ltd. to comply with AS/4256 parts 1 & 5: 2006.

The sheet shall have a gauge of *10 mm and a width of **1050 mm.

The sheeting shall be fixed in accordance with Ampelite's ***H-Bar system.

Both the sheeting and glazing bars will be supplied to conform with the nominated colour.

Sheeting shall be installed in accordance with Ampelite fixing instructions and AS1562.3:2006 Design and installation of sheet roof and wall cladding Part 3: Plastic."



Ampelite Lexan* Thermoclear* has been used on many of the largest sports stadiums in the world, including the Sydney and Beijing Olympic stadium. This is largely due to the proprietary surface coating technology, which has superior resistance to outdoor weathering.

According to accelerated 4,000 hours weathering tests, Ampelite Lexan* Thermoclear* multiwall sheet is superior to other available polycarbonate multiwall glazing products. This is reflected through a superior ten year limited written warranty.

Ampelite Lexan* Thermoclear* is also warranted for 10 years against hail damage and excessive loss of light transmission. Please consult your nearest Ampelite office for full warranty details.

Handling, Storage and Cleaning

Ampelite Lexan* Thermoclear* system should be stored and protected against atmospheric influences like sun, rain, etc. Prolonged exposure to sunlight may cause the protective masking stick making removal difficult.

Stacking of sheets should be on a flat surface with the longest lengths on the bottom. As with all glazing materials, care should be exercised when handling and transporting in order to prevent scratches and damage to the edges of the sheets.

Periodic cleaning using correct procedures can help prolong service life. Contact Ampelite for cleaning recommendations.

Sealants

Most silicones are incompatible with polycarbonate. They will damage the sheet, restrict expansion and contraction and void the warranty. Expansion and contraction is allowed for in the specialized glazing system. Therefore silicone is not generally required. Should one be required Ampelite can provide one that is compatible.

Safety Recommendations

Consider all safety requirements when working at heights. Never walk on or apply your load directly to sheeting. A temporary wooden board or other device, supported by roof members should always be used.

All safety practices must comply with the applicable local and statutory building regulations. For most applications above 3m safety mesh should be used. Some sheet structures may be used without safety mesh as per AS1562.3:2006. Please consult your nearest Ampelite office for details.
